



### **This kit in resin contains:**

- A conversion kit for Tiran 5 or 4, IDF or SLA (based on the T-55/54 of Trumpeter.)
- A figure.
- A Dozer blade.
- A manual of assembly in two sheets first side / reverse.

### **In this manual of assemblage you will find:**

- On the first sheet: the manual step by step. Each picture represents a step and parts required for each step are indicated at the top left of each picture (part number relating to the nomenclature of second sheet).
- On the second sheet: you will find the nomenclature that is to be placed next to the sheet for assembly in refer to each number.
- So a historical text.

### **Useful Advises:**

This kit is not recommended for children under 10 years. Keep out of reach of children. They should not be allowed to ingest small pieces or manipulate the plastic bags in any way. It is recommended to use glue cyanoacrylate.

### **Historic:**

The Tiran 5 or 4 takes birth in the late 1960s. At the times, Israel had captured a number of T-55/54 and decided to improve them. The Israeli firms added several boxes and baskets on the turret, as well as on the frame of the tank.


These tanks are equipped with a new communication system and therefore antennas visible on the turret. We also see the presence of skid tracks and jerry cans on the turret. It is these transformations that correspond to the name of the family of Tiran.

The Tiran 5 has a 105mm gun and is used by the IDF while Tiran 4 has a 100mm gun and is used by the SLA or the Lebanese army.







The Dozer blade is also constructed by Israel.
