**This kit in resin contains:**

- A resin conversion kit for M-66 Makmat, based of Sherman's Hasegawa. Kit realized for the Wargame. (IDF, SLA)
- A manual of assembly in two sheets first side / reverse.

**In this manual of assemblage you will find:**

- On the first sheet: the manual step by step. Each picture represents a step and parts required for each step are indicated at the top left of each picture (part number relating to the nomenclature of second sheet).
- On the second sheet: you will find the nomenclature that is to be placed next to the sheet for assembly in refer to each number.
- So a historical text.

**Useful Advises:**

This kit is not recommended for children under 10 years. Keep out of reach of children. They should not be allowed to ingest small pieces or manipulate the plastic bags in any way.  
It Is recommande to use glue cyanoacrylate.

**Historic:**

The M-66 is Makmat Israeli design, built by the Israeli Military Industries (IMI) and the firm Soltam (for the mortar).

It is developed specifically for infantry support. This motorized artillery is based on a Sherman hull and bear a powerful 160mm mortar. Moreover, "Makmat" means "mortar."

It entered service in 1968 in Israel and participated in the Yom Kippur War in 1973 and in Operation Litani in 1978, or yet during the first Lebanon War in 1982.

In 1995, the M-66 is removed from service Makmat in Israel. Some copies are still used until 2000 in the South Lebanon Army (SLA). Some Makmat will be captured by Hezbollah.


