



### **This kit contains:**

- A complete kit of L-33 Ro'em in resin.
- A figure in resin.
- A manual of assembly in two sheets first side / reverse.

### **In this manual of assemblage you will find:**

- On the first sheet: the manual step by step. Each picture represents a step and parts required for each step are indicated at the top left of each picture (part number relating to the nomenclature of second sheet).
  - On the second sheet: you will find the nomenclature that is to be placed next to the sheet for assembly in refer to each number.

### **Useful Advises:**

This kit is not recommended for children under 10 years. Keep out of reach of children. They should not be allowed to ingest small pieces or manipulate the plastic bags in any way. It Is recommande to use the glue cyanoacrylate.

### **Historic:**

The L-33, appointed Ro'em is a vehicle auto-propelled artillery from Israeli design, built by firms Soltam and IMI.

It is based on Sherman chassis M4A3E8 and launched and shells of 155mm M68, on an range of 20 km. Its crew is made up of eight men.


The driver is located on the left front of the vehicle where the three windows allows him to have a good view of the road.



The L-33 Ro'em entered service in 1968, used during the Yom Kippur War (1973) and the First Lebanon War (1982). Between 150 to 200 L-33 were produced.

Today, it is no longer in service. It should be replaced by the L-39, which has never emerged.
