Useful Advises:

This kit is not recommended for children under 10 years. Keep out of reach of children. They should not be allowed to ingest small pieces or manipulate the plastic bags in any way. It is recommended to use the cyanoacrylate glue and to degrease parts before gluing.

Historic:

VBL ("Véhicule Blindé Léger") comes from the French firm Panhard from the 1980s. This vehicle has many functions, mainly that of performing reconnaissance and liaison. It is protected against NBC attacks. It is air-transportable, heli-transportable, parachutable and amphibious. He entered service in the French Army in 1990.

The version presented here is equipped with a 7.62mm machine gun as well as equipment specially used in OPEX (External operation): Antenna, cable cutter, (flag for the UNIFIL version), bag, jericans

This version is found in many conflicts: Lebanon, Afghanistan or Mali, in three NATO tones or even used by UNIFIL in white.


