Useful Advises:

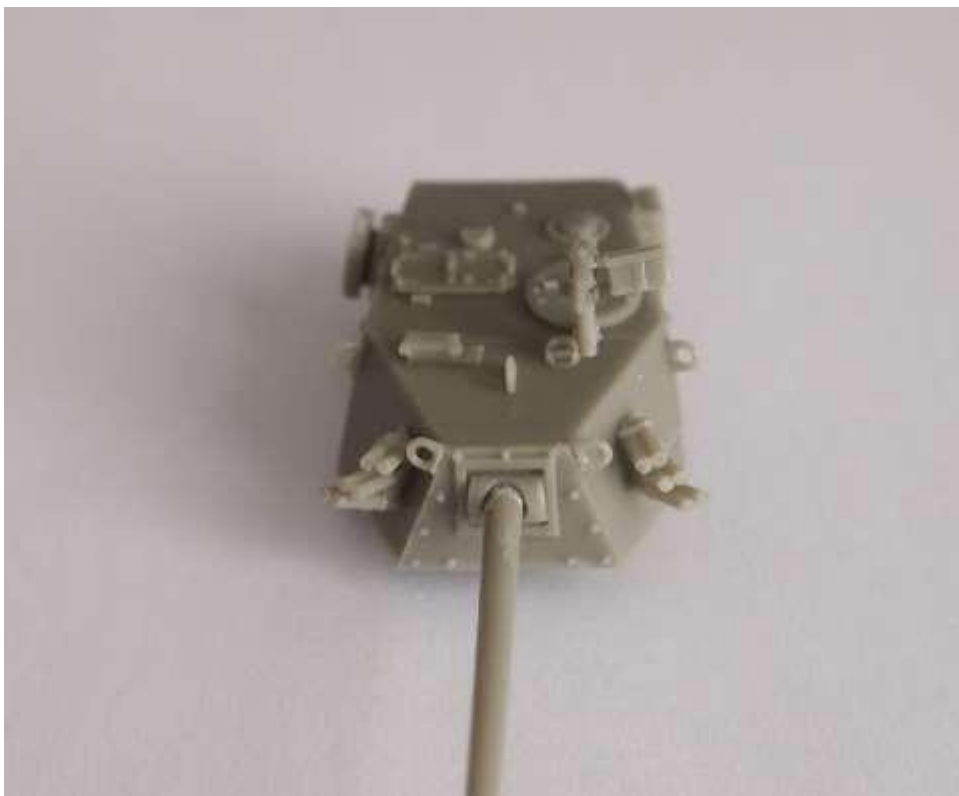
This kit is not recommended for children under 10 years. Keep out of reach of children. They should not be allowed to ingest small pieces or manipulate the plastic bags in any way.

Historic:

The charioteer tank destroyer was built in the 1950s, on a Cromwell Cruiser and is equipped with a 20pounder main gun from Centurion.

It was used during Operation "Litani" in 1978 and during the Lebanese civil war. PLO, (Palestine Liberation Organization) has recovered some tank of the Lebanese army in the 1990s.

From 1954, Jordan utilised in his army this tank. The figure by Model Miniature proposed by a Jordanian soldier.
This tank was also used by Austria, Finland
